Construction Update

Crow Wing County has entered into a contract with Borden Excavating for the reconstruction of Inglewood Drive from Woida Road to CSAH 77. The construction work will consist of grade widening, aggregate base, and bituminous surfacing. Beginning on August 31st, through traffic will be detoured from the construction site. The detour route will utilize CSAH 77, TH 371, and Woida Road.

Although the road will be open to local traffic for the duration of the construction project, there will be stages of construction such as culvert installations where it will be very difficult to navigate through the construction zone. Please plan your daily route accordingly, expect delays, take extra time to drive safely, and respect the contractor's equipment and operators. At the end of each working day, the Contractor is required to have the road passable for access to your property. Coordination will be ongoing to update Emergency Management personnel and local law enforcement on the conditions of the road as construction progresses.

Due to the construction operations, temporary mailboxes will be set up at the Baxter water tower site near Woida Road. Your existing mailbox support will be removed and left near your entrance. Once construction operations are complete, the Contractor will install your existing mailbox or one provided by you on a new swing away mailbox support.

Weather permitting and barring unforeseen circumstances, the current schedule has grading operations completed by September 18th, paving completed by September 25th, and all construction work completed by October 3, 2015. Your patience and understanding through this construction project is appreciated.
